Create a 3-piece wardrobe that includes a skirt, top and jacket. Join designer and nationally known teacher Pam Howard for 2 days of Sewing With a Plan (SWAP) using knits. Pam specializes in couture tailoring, advanced sewing techniques, and fitting.

In this 2-day workshop you will learn how to flatter your proportions, no matter your figure type. Topics include working with different knit fabrics, stabilizing knits, use of double needles, suitable weights/types of interfacing, pressing, as well as choosing the right shapes and proportions for your figure.

Garments will be cut out prior to the start of class in most cases. A supply list and additional instructions for preparation will be provided after you register. Please pack a lunch for Saturday.

Note that this class is a repeat of the one presented Feb 2011.

Suggested fabrics for your 3-piece wardrobe include wool, rayon, or silk jersey, matte jersey, cotton or rayon interlock knits for tops, pants and skirts. You can also consider wool double knit (usually with Lycra) and textured or novelty knits for jackets.

\*SWAP: Sewing With A Plan—a sewing process that builds a wardrobe of interchangeable pieces for a pulled-together look.
